1. Entries close 26th October 2018 at the Egmont A&P Association PO Box 29 Hawera or the Show Office Burnside Avenue.
2. Entrants must be High School students years 10-13 at time of entry
3. All entrants must be available to attend the workshop on 15th November and painting for two days 16th and 17th November 2018.
4. The theme for artwork must align with the Royal Agricultural movement.
5. All entry forms must be accompanied by an A4 size drawing/painting of proposed artwork.
6. The first 20 entries only will be accepted.
7. All paint and brushes will be supplied.
8. Prize Money 1st \$300, 2nd \$200, 3rd \$100
9. The Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. All entrants will receive a free entry pass for two days to the Hawera Auto Court Egmont A&P Show 2018.
11. Spectators must pay gold coin entry to the show.
12. Approximate painting space will be 2 metres wide by 2 metres high.
13. The Egmont A&P Association reserves the right to make changes and/or alterations to the workshop and/or competition schedule and conditions as they see fit.
14. Competitors must comply with Egmont A&P Associations Health and Safety guidelines and the Health & Safety at work Act 2015.
