1. Entrants participate at their own risk, the Egmont A&P Association accept no responsibility for loss or damage of entrants property or vehicles during the event.
2. The Egmont A&P Association reserves the right to refuse entry to any parties that do not meet the requirements specified in this document.
3. Entrants that are deemed unsuitable by Egmont A&P Association for the target audience of young children and their families will not be permitted to participate.
4. Drinking and/or possessing liquor is prohibited prior to or during the parade.
5. Offensive language may not to be used at any time during the parade.
6. Each entrant must allocate a representative who is present on the day and responsible for all matters regarding the entry.
7. Entrants may allocate two personnel to walk either side of their float to monitor safety.
8. Egmont A&P Association will allocate safety wardens to monitor speed.
9. No object may be thrown from a vehicle including sweets or handouts.
10. Walkers who are walking alongside may give out sweets/handouts
11. All entries must adhere to instruction from the Road Traffic Management officers, Road Staff and/or officers of the Egmont A&P Association.
12. Vehicles must be driven at walking pace for the duration of the parade.
13. Once your vehicle has started along the parade route, no one may board or exit your float.
14. Your entry may not exit the parade route before the end of the parade unless in an emergency.
15. Each entry must adhere to the road rules during and when traveling to or from the parade area.
16. All vehicles or trailers must be road legal with current Registration and Warrant of Fitness or Certificate of Fitness.
17. All vehicles participating in the parade must hold a minimum of third party insurance.
18. Persons driving vehicles must hold the appropriate driver's license for that vehicle.
19. All entrants should hold their own property, vehicle and public liability insurance.
20. All entrants must adhere to the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015.
