RULES

1. Exhibits must be delivered to the Edna Wills Hall Wednesday 20th November 2019 between 10.am and 5.30 pm.
2. Prize giving will be held at 3.00 pm Saturday 23rd November 2019,Edna Wills Hall.
3. Late entries may be refused.
4. Where points are given, points to count as follows; 1st 3 points, 2nd 2 points, a. 3rd 1 point, In the event of a tie for Points Prize most 1st prizes to count.
5. Committee reserves the right to substitute prizes of value for cash prizes.
6. All entries judged at discretion of judge.
7. All prize money and entry fees inclusive of GST.
8. If 3 entries or less in a class only one prize will be paid, this may be first or second.
9. Prize money will be paid by the Stewards Saturday from 12 – 4pm, Saturday 23rd November 2019 at the Edna Wills Hall.
- 10.The Committee reserves the right to substitute product prizes of similar value for cash.
- 11.The Association reserves the right to make changes and alterations to the schedule as it sees fit.
- 12.All prize money will be forfeited if not collected by 29th November 2019 from the Secretary's office, Burnside Ave.
- 13.Definition of amateur, one who does not make a living from doing a particular work.
- 14.All entries must be clean and new - the bona fide work of exhibitor.
- 15.Exhibits previously placed in an Egmont A&P Show are not eligible to enter.
- 16.All articles/exhibits must be in their finished, mounted or framed state.
- 17.To ensure exhibition it is necessary that all exhibits have the name and full address of the exhibitor and the class number attached to every exhibit.
- 18.No delivery of exhibits will be given without an order from the Chief Steward, and no exhibit can be removed before prize giving on the second day of the show.
- 19.Exhibits to be collected between 3.30 and 5.00 pm on Saturday 23rd November 2019
- 20.The Committee will not under any circumstances be responsible for loss, damage or miss-delivery of an exhibit.
- 21.Points prize to count only for individual entries, not grouped.
- 22.No limit to entries per person per class.
