## COLOUR CLASSES

### <u>Multi Colour</u>

- 10 Pinto & Appaloosa Any broken coloured horse
- 11 Minimal/maximum Pinto any broken coloured horse that has either 20% or less colour on a mainly white horse or 20% or less white on a mainly coloured horse. *MUST HAVE APPROVAL FROM AIMHCNZ BEFORE YOU CAN ENTER THIS CLASS contact show secretary*

### Solid Colour

- 12 Silver &Dilute silver bay, silver dapple, silver buckskin, palomino, buckskin, dun, cremello, champagne, perlino.
- 13 Solid Colour Other blacks, bays, greys, chestnuts, true roans

<u>CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION COLOUR</u> Judged from 1<sup>st</sup> placegetters

Break for lunch 1 – 1 1/2 hours –the public will be invited to come and interact with the horses, try the obstacles, a water relay event, western cones etc.

We will also use this opportunity to have an open club practice time over the obstacles put out for the day: Water pool, backing poles, hoops, see-saw, mat, side passing, gate, etc.

\* Children under 10yrs old MUST be accompanied by an adult, anyone interacting with the horses must be wearing closed in shoes for safety.

## PERFORMANCE CLASSES

#### LONG REINING

Horses are to compete with an open bridle (no blinkers), and is to include a suitable bit. You need to carry a driving whip. Horses competing in Long reining may NOT compete in any other driving class at this show.

Minimum ACTUAL age for Long reining – 24 months

14 Long Reining Best Paced & Mannered – Category A & B combined

### TRAIL CLASSES A & B combined

15 Novice Horse

## JUMPING CLASSES

### HUNTER CATEGORY A

Novice Horse Hunter (horse to be 3 yrs and over, of actual age) – no jump shall exceed 24"
Open Horse Hunter (horse to be 3 yrs and over, of actual age) – no jump shall exceed 28"

### HUNTER CATEGORY B

- 19 Novice Horse Hunter (horse to be 3 yrs and over, of actual age) no jump shall exceed 28"
- 20 Open Horse Hunter (horse to be 3 yrs and over, of actual age) no jump shall exceed 32"
- Introductory Hunter- Cat A, B combined, Course will be 4 jumps no jump shall exceed 18"
  For horses that need some experience before competing in novice.
  (Horse to be 2 years of actual age and over and is not eligible for any other jumping class, except 2 yr old jumper & youth).

#### <u>Fault N Out</u>

- 22 Cat A (horse to be 3 yrs and over, of actual age)
- 23 Cat B (horse to be 3 yrs and over, of actual age)

# Hi-point Horse of the Show Cat A & Cat B

#### automatic entry

Classes to count – 1 Halter Breed class, 1 colour class, 1 Trail class (Nov/open), 1 Hunter class (Nov/open).

#### Points system for Hi-point Horse of the day:

First place – 8 points; Second place – 6 points, Third place – 4 points; Fourth place – 2 points When competing with 4 or more horses.

First place – 6 points; Second place – 4 points, Third place – 2 points When competing with 3 horses.

First place – 4 points; Second place – 2 points When competing with 2 horses.

First place – 2 points When competing with 1 horse. There will be no ties:

If there is a tie, placings will be counted back to number of firsts then number of seconds and so on. If results still tie, the horse that has the highest placing in its trail class shall split the tie.
