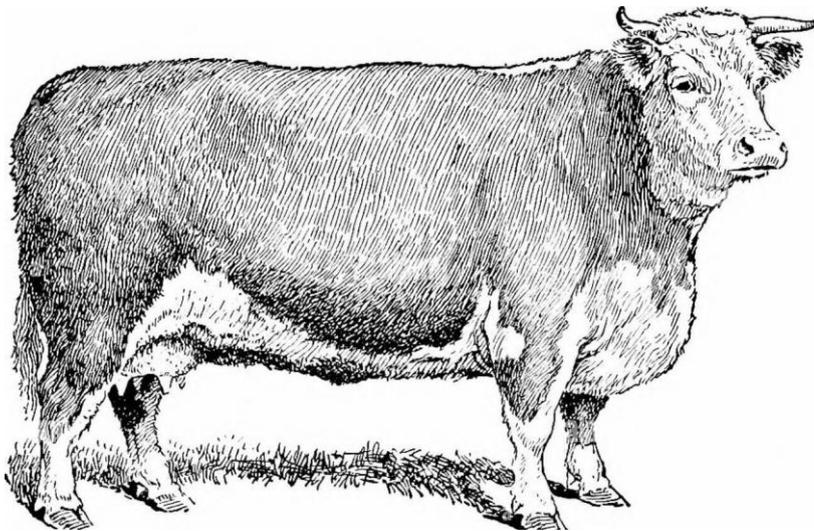

## TB Testing - Ospri Definition and Requirements

1. All animals entered for showing or exhibiting must be from a current TB Clear Status Herd.
2. All animals entered for showing must be from a herd that is current with its TB testing Requirements.
3. The Association must be notified, within 48 hours, of any TB testing that results in potential TB issues being identified after entries have been submitted. This will include TB testing of animals associated with those entered for showing. Owners entering cattle must sign any declaration printed on the entry form.
4. All animals entered that originate from a movement control area, must be notified at the time of entry. These animals, if aged 90 days or older, must complete a clear pre-movement TB test within 60 days of their movement to the show.
5. Exhibitors must bring a copy of AHB form for collection upon arrival

## Nait Compliance Definition and Requirements

**All stock must be NAIT registered and in accordance with OSPRI and TBfree New Zealand. Regardless of age they must be**

- Departing from a property that is registered with a NAIT number and TBfree NZ herd number accompanied with a copy of a valid Animal Status Declaration form.
- Fitted with a valid NAIT RFID tag and registered in the NAIT system.
- **Registered in a movement to the event NAIT number (12985005) from the animal's current NAIT number no later than Friday 28th October. Please bring a copy of your Nait transfer with you.**
- Registered in a return movement from the event NAIT number to their destination (receiving NAIT number) within 48 hours of departure.
- All stock over 90 days of age travelling from within a TBfree Movement Control Area must be pre-movement tested within 60 days of arriving at the event.
- **Once unloaded and stalled, stewards will come around and electronically scan nait tags and collect completed TB/ASD docketts.**
- **In accordance with MPI regulations** the Egmont A & P Show operates a policy of **No Nait, No Show, No exceptions**
- **All entries must include Nait RFID numbers specific to each individual animal entered (how to find your RFID number{s} is shown below).**

## Egmont A & P General Rules

- All Bulls 12 months and over MUST be led with a halter and permanent nose ring with lead
- ALL Senior Bulls 2 years and over may be led by 1 person but with 1 person on standby (ringside). Both leaders must be capable adults.
- All females yearling and over MUST be led with a halter and a nose clip with lead.
- HIGHLAND cattle entries must have an RAS issued passport number.
- A minimum 2-meter gap must be maintained between studs at all times
- Wash bays must be kept clean at all times
  
- **NO STOCK IS TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS WITHOUT PERMISSION OF BEEF STEWARD**
  
- **ALL ANIMALS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER**
  
- **TROPHYS ARE AVAILABLE FOR PHOTOGRAPHY PURPOSES ONLY- THEY ARE NOT TO LEAVE THE GROUNDS**

### Terms & Conditions of Entry

- 1) All exhibitors accept the associations conditions of entry and indemnify the association under the provisions of the Health and Safety in Employment act 2015 and subsequent amendments.
- 2) Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and will be held accountable for their safety.
- 3) Exhibitors must comply with all current NZ animal welfare legislation.
- 4) The association reserves the right to request the removal of exhibitors and/or animals from the showground if they are deemed unruly, unsafe or unmanageable.
- 5) Exhibitors, spectators and anyone within the Beef area including grandstand, car parking, wash bay, stalling or surrounding areas enter at their own risk and no claim shall be made against the association.
- 6) The RAS yellow card system covers all sections of an RAS affiliated show and may be offered for any inappropriate behavior towards show/event/judges/helpers/competitors or anyone else associated with the affiliated show. This may mean the immediate removal of exhibitor and their animals
- 7) Any animal exhibited may be tested for Drugs of Forbidden substances at the show under the by-laws and regulations adopted by the RAS. This will be performed onsite by a veterinarian if foul play is suspected
- 8) Cattle tags supplied on the day for animal identification must be returned at the conclusion of the event. \$5/tag will be charged to the exhibitor if not returned
- 9) Sawdust will be provided for stalling. All used bedding and feed must be removed from the stall prior to departure and disposed of in the bins provided
- 10) Silage will be provided as feed for the stock - all other feed must be supplied by the owner
